<p><b>Tuesday 12th January</b></p>	 <p><b>Making Bread</b></p> <p>We will be using a simple recipe to bake our own bread. We will share the recipe with you so you can have a go at home. In making our own bread we will be developing our physical skills in stirring, kneading and spreading using kitchenware including cutlery and utensils.</p>	
<p><b>Wednesday 13th January</b></p>	<p><b>Salt dough</b></p> <p>We will be using salt dough to create buns and bread for our bakers shop. The children will be using their baking skills but then getting creative to make models of things to sell in our shop using different modelling tools and paints. We will share the salt dough recipe with you to try at home.</p>	
<p><b>Thursday 14th January</b></p>	 <p><b>Sign of the week</b></p> <p>Our Makaton sign is "wash hands". We will use it to talk to your child this week. We encourage hand washing for 20 seconds regularly at the start and end of school and between activities</p>	
<p><b>Friday 15th January</b></p>	 <p>Download the 50 things app and have a go at #12 Brrrr... Explore the cold! Snow, ice and cold weather are experiences that children can find exciting; they need to discover our world using all their senses to understand it, and snow is a great opportunity for play!
