	<p>As a Nursery School we have remained open to all children throughout the current lockdown, however this week we look forward to welcoming back any children who may have spent lockdown at home. We continue to have our Covid Risk Assessment in place and thank you all for following our procedures. You may notice adults wearing face coverings around school more. <p>Monday 8th March</p>	<p>Living Eggs are arriving today!</p>  <p>We will be taking care of 10 eggs in an incubator. We will be able to watch and see when the eggs begin to hatch. The eggs will stay at school for 2 weeks and will help us to learn and understand the life cycle of a chicken and how to take care of them.</p>
<p>Tuesday 9th March</p>	<p>Amazing Eggs</p>  <p>We will be using a non-fiction book to learn all about which animals lay eggs, how an egg hatches and what might be inside an egg. Non-fiction books are a good way for children to learn about the world around them and encourage curiosity. <p>Wednesday 10th March</p>	<p>Hydroponics</p> <p>In Green room we have set up our new plant growing system. Hydroponics is a way of growing plants indoors. The children have helped to set it up and are now enjoying observing and caring for basil, lettuce and cherry tomatoes. We can't wait to watch them grow and then enjoy them for our snack!</p> 
<p>Thursday 11th March</p>	<p>Sign of the week</p>  <p>Our Makaton sign this week is "egg". We will use this sign to support our learning as we observe the living eggs and look at books to learn about the animals that come from eggs.</p>
<p>Friday 12th March</p>	<p>Download the 50 things app and try #33 Home from Home</p>  <p>Making dens is a favourite activity at nursery – you may have seen some of our outdoor dens in the garden.
