The children have been talking about where they live and how they travel to school. They have spent lots of time exploring our nursery garden. We have had conversations about the leaves on the trees. We will extend this interest by looking at the changes of autumn in our garden and local area. We will go on walks around our school community and look at leaf shapes and colours and the apples that grow on our trees. We will use the apples in our baking activities and recipes.

Core Story

GREEN Room

'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' is a wonderful book full of repetition and rhythm.

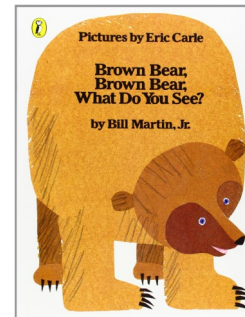
We will use the story to sequence and re-enact roles. We will think about what happened next and try to recall events from the story.



ORANGE and PURPLE Room

Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do you See?

We will use Makaton signs and symbols, songs and rhymes to support teaching the sequence of the story, the animals and their colours. We will think about the sequence of the animals in the book.



New Routines

Throughout our group times, planned activities and playing together in the classroom and outside we will focus on your child's mental health and wellbeing as they settle in and form relationships with us and each other.

We will encourage your child to be independent with things like their coat and bag. We will support children to tidy up after they have finished playing and teach them how to handle the resources with care.

50 things activities are low cost activities to do as a family that will support your child's communication skills and confidence.

We will share one activity each week that you can do at home to support your child's learning.
