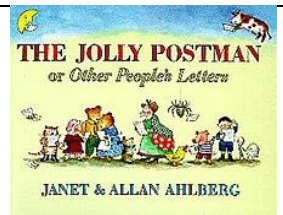

The children will watch a live theatre performance in the hall this morning about a magical clockmaker and a mouse! You are welcome to come and join us.



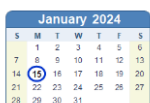
