Word of the Week

Our 2-year-old vocabulary focus this week will be **'baguette'**. We will talk about different types of bread and when they are eaten. We will use words to describe what it looks and feels like. Talk to your child about the bread you eat at home; where you buy from and how you make it. Talk about the different brands and types of packaging.
